We continue to stay busy receiving completed correspondence course lessons from the various individuals we enrolled last month and pray we may see some fruit from those efforts as well. One lesson came back uncompleted with a note stating that she didn't have a bible, but if she had one she'd take the course. My wife and I visited her at her home and equipped her with a bible of her own and encouraged her to go through the lessons.

Currently, I'm in the middle of a gospel meeting I'm preaching at in Cameron, OH. I'm looking forward to the opportunity to help spread the gospel in this area. One young brother here is dating a girl who is a member of one of the liberal congregations in the area and assured me she will be attending this Thursday evening. I'll be preaching a lesson on establishing biblical authority and will be dealing with the various liberal practices the congregation she attends has been engaging in. We pray it may lead to further studies to help open her eyes to the error of adding to the word of God and the need to submit and follow the specific pattern set for the church in the word of God. Her father is one of the elders of this liberal group, so there is certainly the potential to make a significant difference in the direction this congregation goes.

Beth's pregnancy continues to go well. Alice stays pretty active, I can feel her kicking and moving a lot more now. We're in the process of turning one of the bedrooms in the house into a nursery and anxiously awaiting her arrival.
