The work here in Waverly, OH continues to go well. We had 2 restorations this past month (one brother and one sister) and both continue to show improvements in their faithfulness. The brother I have been studying with who had been struggling a great deal continues to show steady improvements as he makes changes in his life in an effort to be more steadfast in his faith and service. Recently, I've had the opportunity to study with a man who had been trying to study his way out of the Jehovah's Witnesses (Leon Caulley). The more he observed their practices and teachings the more he began to question the validity of their faith. When we studied together and he saw how the scriptures corroborated his own doubts of their various teaching, he was overwhelmed with joy and has requested further studies. He now not only is requesting further scriptural ammunition to use to combat their efforts of converting him (apparently they make frequent visits, some even offering to help with chores and errands in attempts to acquire more time to influence him with their doctrines), but is also requesting studies that may show him the difference between the Church of Christ and denominationalism (he kept offering me money and gifts after our study, and as I continued to refuse to accept them, he asked what he could possibly do to repay me, so I said there was one thing he could do, and that was to visit the Bethel Church of Christ where brother Pat Gamp preaches which is just 15 minutes away from him...apparently he immediately recognized the unique manner of worship from his visit that was unlike other services he had been exposed to in other denominations). I'll also be getting the opportunity to study with a brother from one of the liberal congregations in the area this Thursday. Two men have been attending recently after the liberal congregation they were members of closed its doors. One of them, after noticing that we do not have social meals in the building, has requested a study on this matter, and Lord willing we be able to discuss it Thursday evening as planned.
